Dare devil legal eagles' charity sky dive

A daring sky dive over the Shropshire countryside has helped two secretaries from Warrington law firm Forshaws Davies Ridgway to raise more than £700 for charity.

Deborah Coppack, 31 (pictured left), mother of 16 month old twins, and 45 year old Martina Hughes (pictured right), also a mother of two children, parachuted out of an aircraft in a tandem jump over Tilstock Airfield, near Whitchurch.

Martina said later: "I must be completely bonkers doing this at my age but it was totally awesome. I was on a real high afterwards and I still can't stop smiling."

A former pupil of Brookvale Comprehensive School in Runcorn, Martina has worked as a secretary for Forshaws Davies Ridgway for nearly 23 years and is now a PA in the Family Department. Her jump was made in aid of World Cancer Research, in support of her cousin who has recently been diagnosed with bowel cancer.



Deborah, who is a former pupil of Stockton Heath Primary School and Bridgewater High School, has worked as a legal secretary for around six years. Describing herself as an “adrenalin junkie”, she said: “I can’t wait to tell the twins all about Mummy’s great leap once they’re older. I decided to take part in the sky dive to raise money and awareness for the MS Trust because my father-in-law was diagnosed with the disease 11 years ago.
