Kingsley Players are back on stage again in October (19-21) with a performance of Richard Everett's poignant play, Entertaining Angels.

The five strong cast are led by experienced actress Kath Kerry in the lead part of Grace, the widowed vicar's wife – a role played by Penelope Keith in the recent West End production.

With sharp-edged comedy and probing wit, this new play asks whether God can be trusted to do anything right. As a clergy wife, Grace has spent a lifetime on her best behaviour. Now, following the death of her husband, Bardolph (played by Malcolm Barker), she is enjoying the new-found freedom to do exactly as she pleases. But the return of her eccentric missionary sister, Ruth (played by Sue Elliott), together with some disturbing revelations, force Grace to confront the truth of her marriage.

Entertaining Angels marks the directing debut of Fiona Crane and the cast is completed with Laura Williams and Helsby High School sixth former Hazel Clarke.

The play runs for four nights at Kingsley Community Centre, with performances starting at 7.30pm.
