Hit musical 'Oliver!' on stage in Kingsley in January

Lionel Bart's hit musical *Oliver!* bursts into life on stage at Kingsley Community Centre at the end of January. The Kingsley Players will performing the much-loved show for five performances, Wednesday 27th – Saturday 30th January, 2016, including a Saturday matinee.
