New foreign currency exchange service launched by Halton Chamber

Halton businesses who trade abroad could save hundreds of pounds, thanks to a new foreign currency exchange service launched by Halton Chamber of Commerce.

Working in partnership with Moneycorp, any Chamber member can now access a range of financial services which could ease the transfer of money to and from countries overseas.

The service includes a free health check to assess a business's foreign exchange needs. Moneycorp can buy and sell in 35 currencies and offer more competitive exchange rates and transfer fees currently offered by British banks. All their work is authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority

Chamber chief executive Paula Cain said: "With exchange rates currently in favour of British companies who trade overseas, this is a great time for UK businesses to expand their exporting activity.

"Halton Chamber's link with Moneycorp will ease the foreign exchange process and give our members a competitive edge. This service is the latest in a portfolio of extra benefits which give Chamber members access to expert help in specialist fields such as human resources and employment law.
